

Fuels Reduction Projects in Paradise and Magalia

Purple:

- 2001 - *Upper Ridge Fuel Reduction Project* - 13 miles of Fuel Reduction around Paradise Pines and along Nimshew Rd. Funded by US Forest Service WUI grant. Partnerships- Upper Ridge Coordinating Council, Paradise Pines Property Owners Association, CAL-FIRE and BCFSC.
- 2003 - *Upper Ridge Fuel Reduction Phase II* - Completion of 5 additional miles in Magalia. Funded by Butte County Title III HR2389 funds and US Forest Service. Partnerships- Paradise Irrigation District and BCFSC.
- 2002 - *Greenbelt Fuel Reduction* - Construction of shaded fuel breaks in the Paradise Pines Owners Association greenbelt. Funded by Butte County Title III HR2389 funds. Partnerships - Upper Ridge Coordinating Council and BCFSC.

Orange:

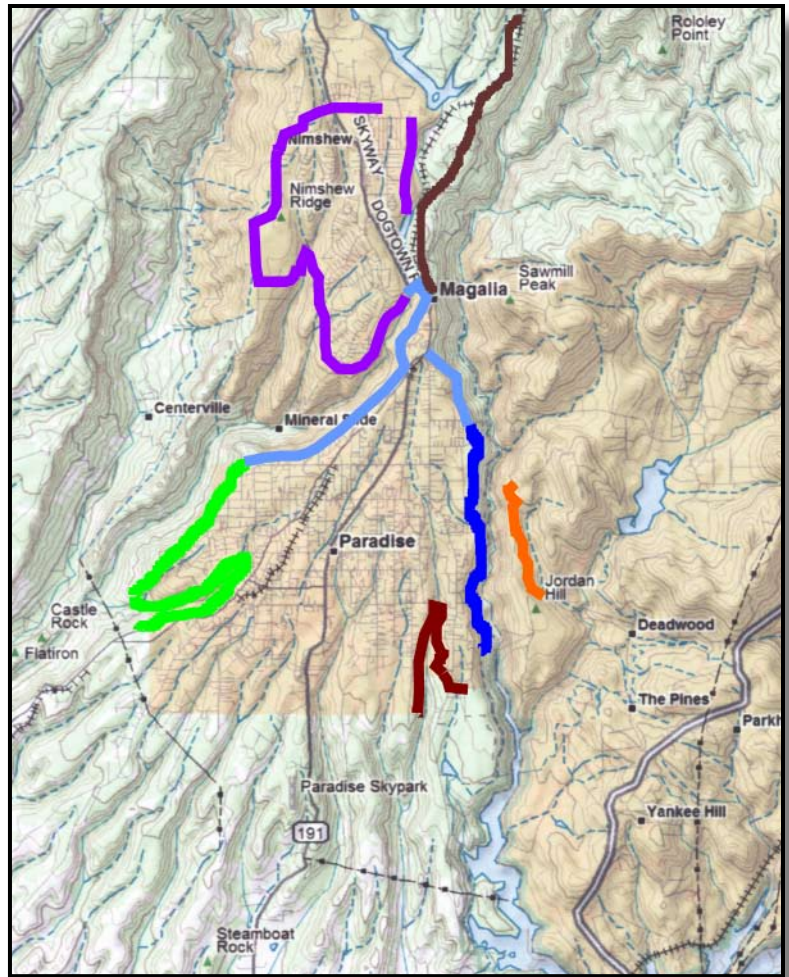
- 2003 - *Jordan Hill Fuel Reduction Project* - 3.5 miles of roadside fuel reduction on Jordan Hill Road in Concow, providing access for fire personnel and residents access for evacuation on a ridge line parallel to Paradise. Funded by BLM and Butte County Title III HR2389 funds. Partnerships- Yankee Hill Fire Safe Council and BCFSC.

Dark Blue:

- 2003 - *West Branch Fuel Reduction Project* - 3 mile fuel reduction project along the eastern edge of Paradise. Funded by BLM. Partnerships - Town of Paradise Fire Department, Town of Paradise Fire Safe Council and BCFSC.

Light Blue:

- 2004 - *Top of Paradise Fuel Reduction Project* - 6 mile fuel reduction project in upper Paradise on both the northeastern and northwestern flank. Funded by BLM. Partnership -Town of Paradise Fire Department, Town of Paradise FSC and BCFSC.
- 2004 - *Dean Rd Roadside Fuel Reduction* - One mile of roadside fuel reduction east of Paradise. Funded by BLM. Partnerships- Town of Paradise Fire Department, Town of Paradise FSC and BCFSC.



Dark Brown:

- 2007 - *Coutolenc Rd. Shaded Fuel Break and Watershed Protection Project* - 4 miles along Coutolenc Rd. Funded by Proposition 40. Partnerships - Cal-Fire and BCFSC.

Red:

- 2007 - *Dry Creek Fuel Reduction Project*- 2 mile fuel reduction in Dry Creek Canyon. Funded by Proposition 40. Partnerships - Town of Paradise Fire Department, Town of Paradise FSC, Cal-Fire and BCFSC.

Green:

- 2008 - *West Paradise Fuel Reduction* - 1/2 mile fuel reduction project along the canyon edge of Paradise. Project funded by BLM. Partnerships - Town of Paradise Fire Department, Town of Paradise FSC and BCFSC
- 2008 - *Honey Run Fuel Reduction Project* - 3.6 mile fuel reduction project along the canyon edge of Paradise funded by Proposition 40 and BLM. Partnerships - Town of Paradise Fire Department, Town of Paradise FSC, CAL-FIRE and BCFSC.
